Reminder to claim unclaimed dividend and shares credited to IEPF

Pursuant to the Composite Scheme of Arrangement under sections 230 to 232 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules framed thereunder, which was sanctioned by the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai Bench, vide its Order dated August 12, 2022, and which was effective from August 18, 2022 ('Scheme'), shareholders of Piramal Enterprises Limited (*which has been merged into Piramal Finance Limited effective from September 16, 2025*) ('PEL/Transferor Company') were allotted equity shares of Piramal Pharma Limited ('the Company') in the ratio of four fully paid-up equity shares of the Company for each fully paid-up equity share of the Transferor Company, held as on the Demerger Record Date i.e. September 1, 2022.

This communication is addressed to those shareholders of the Transferor Company whose PEL shares were in the Investor Education and Protection Fund ("IEPF") account as on the Demerger Record Date. Please note that your corresponding entitlement of the Company's shares were also credited to IEPF.

Accordingly, we encourage to claim your shares along with the related corporate benefits from IEPF. To do so, you may submit your claim by following the below mentioned steps:

1. Visit the official website of IEPF at <https://www.iepf.gov.in>
2. Click on "Claim Refund". You will be redirected to the website of Ministry of Corporate Affairs.
3. Download and fill Form IEPF – 5 online (MCA Services >IEPF related services>IEPF-5).
4. Submit the Form IEPF-5 and note the Service Request Number.
5. After submission, take a printout of the completed Form IEPF-5.
6. Send the physical copy of Form IEPF-5 and requisite documents enumerated therein to the Nodal Officer of the Company at its Registered Office:
7. The Company will verify your application and send a verification report to the IEPF Authority.
8. Upon successful verification, the IEPF Authority will process your claim and credit the shares and unclaimed dividend to your demat account.
